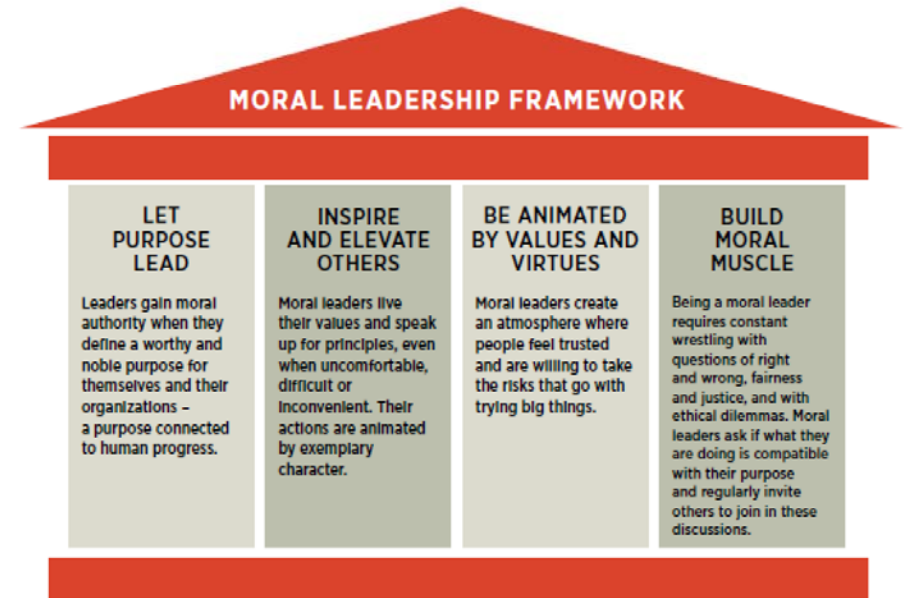




NXT-GEN Fellowship
for Moral Leadership

The **NXT-GEN Fellowship for Moral Leadership** helps leaders build moral authority in their respective realms and then use it to do meaningful things. Participants from business, civil society and government develop their own moral codes, senses of purpose and personal leadership frameworks and skills.

The program draws on lessons from history and moral philosophy to identify the key traits of a moral leader. Participants wrestle with the principles, nuances and application of moral leadership through workshops, case studies and guest speakers and progress through a dynamic curriculum based on four pillars of moral leadership.



Ultimately, the program launches each Fellow on a professional, civic and personal journey which will see them use the skills, mindsets and behaviors they develop to improve their organizations and our society, first through the practicum project, and then for years to come. The program's key features include:
